GENERAL ORDER OF THE PRESIDING JUDGE

In performing its duties to § 3130 et seq. of the Family Code, the Child Abduction and Recovery Unit of the San Bernardino County District Attorney's Office operates on behalf of the Court. It is at times necessary for personnel of the unit to view the information contained in cases filed under the Uniform Parentage Act. In order to facilitate the viewing of these files when necessary, it is ordered as follows:

The Clerk of the Court is hereby directed to allow representatives of the San Bernardino County District Attorney Child Abduction and Recovery Unit access to cases filed pursuant to the Uniform Parentage Act. This will be for the sole purpose of performing the functions described in the aforementioned Code related to locating and recovering abducted children and prosecuting alleged abductors. Unit shall also be permitted to obtain copies, certified or otherwise, as required to perform its duties.

This order is effective January 1, 2024, and supersedes all previous general orders entitled *Granting Access to Uniform Parentage Files and Records*, issued by previous Presiding Judges. This order shall remain in effect until December 31, 2025.
