## NEW UNIFORM COUNTYWIDE BAIL SCHEDULE ADOPTED

**SAN BERNARDINO, CA**—The San Bernardino Superior Court (SBSC) has adopted a new Uniform Countywide Bail Schedule, pursuant to Penal Code §1269b(c) effective June 29, 2020 which sets \$0 bail for all misdemeanors with certain exceptions.

On June 10, 2020, the Judicial Council of California repealed Emergency Rule 4, effective June 20, 2020, which set the Emergency Statewide Bail Schedule due to the Coronavirus pandemic. On June 19, 2020, SBSC extended the use of the Emergency Statewide Bail Schedule through June 28, 2020 to allow for a more comprehensive review of possible changes.

For all offenses for which no presumptive bail is specified in this schedule, the presumptive bail shall be set according to state prison top term potential.

For all enhancements for which no presumptive bail is specified in the schedule, the presumptive bail shall be \$25,000 per year. Should any non-specified triad enhancement for which no presumptive bail is specified in this schedule, the \$25,000 per year shall be applied to the mid-term.

Notwithstanding, any misdemeanor bail schedule, judicial officers are permitted to adjust bail considering factors in PC §1275, 1270 AND 1269c.

Pursuant to Penal Code §1269b(c), San Bernardino County Superior Court adopts uniform countywide bail schedule, effective June 29, 2020.
