SAN BERNARDINO, CA– Pursuant to [Assembly Bill \(AB\) 199](#), specified fees are lowered from \$300 to \$100 and outstanding debt related to those fees are repealed effective July 1, 2022.

By local policy, San Bernardino Superior Court (SBSC) will discontinue adding civil assessments effective July 1, 2022:

Penal Code:

§ 1214.1 Failure to Pay Civil Assessment

§ 1214.1 Failure to Appear Civil Assessment

In alignment with statutory authority, judicial discretion will remain.

The unpaid balance of those civil assessments (pursuant to [AB 199](#)) is unenforceable and uncollectible. All cases with an outstanding balance for the above noted fees will be adjusted to repeal the outstanding balance of those fees.
